

**WOODROW TOWNSHIP**  
**SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**  
**CORRAL LIQUOR LICENSE**

**May 6, 2016**

**3:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order by Chair Bob Hankey at 3:00 p.m. All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance. Present were supervisors Myles Wagner, Tom Lindquist and chair Bob Hankey, and clerk Diane Schires. Absent: Treasurer Tim Mueller.

All in attendance reviewed documents required by the County of Cass to approve the liquor license application for the BC Corral restaurant located in Woodrow Township. All signed the appropriate application and the owner paid in full for the special meeting fee of \$300 (\$75 for each board member and clerk for stipend of \$75 each). A special meeting was required as the applicant needed township approval before the Cass County Commissioners would review the application at their May meeting. Hence, it was a matter of urgency as the County Commissioner's requirement of application fell on a date preceding the Township's regular meeting, held on May 12. All legal requirements for posting of a special meeting of the board were held in compliance.

Meeting was adjourned at 3:15 p.m. on May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016.
